# BUNNY CORNER BOOKMARK








What you need:

- Origami paper (or regular paper cut into a square)
- Wiggle eye stickers
- White paper
- Pen
- Scissors
- Glue

Instructions:

1. Fold the paper diagonally. Unfold.
2. Fold into a triangle (coloured side on the outside). Grab hold of the top of the triangle (one sheet only) and fold it toward the bottom of the triangle.
3. Fold the left and right corner towards the bottom centre of the triangle. Crease and unfold
4. Again grab the corner, this time folding it towards the top of the triangle. Crease well. Do the same with the other side.
5. Now tuck both tops inside the pocket.
6. Now it's time to turn this DIY corner bookmark into a bunny corner bookmark. Cut ears, teeth and snout and glue them on the corner bookmark. Also add two eye stickers (or just draw your own).



# How To Blow Out An Egg

5 minutes (*time spent doing stuff*), 1 hour (*drying time*)

1 hour and 5 minutes (*total project time*)

## Supplies

a clean bowl

a needle, pin, awl, tiny nail, or thumbtack

a toothpick or straightened out paperclip

eggs (*not cooked*)

scotch tape, masking tape, or blue painter's tape

towels

soap and water

## Instructions

Step 1: Start by putting a small piece of tape over both ends of the egg. The tape will help keep the egg shell from cracking when you poke a hole. Take a needle or straight pin and poke a hole into the top (*skinnier*) end of the egg, through the tape. Wiggle the pin around a bit to make the hole just a little bit wider than the pin and to help break up the yolk inside the egg.

Flip the egg over (*over your bowl to catch anything that drips out!*) and poke a second hole on the other end of the egg. Make the hole on the bottom (*fatter*) end of the egg a little bigger than the hole on the top; this is the hole all the egggy insides will come out through.

Step 2: Put your fingers over both holes so nothing comes out, then shake the egg. You want to break up the yolk and all the membranes that hold the egg together (*basically "scrambling" it inside its shell*) so that the egg is liquidy enough to come out through the hole you made.

Step 3: Once you can hear the egg sloshing around inside the shell, hold the egg over your bowl (*bottom/fatter side down*) and blow through the hole at the top of the egg.

Make sure you get a good seal around the egg with your mouth so that all your air is going into the egg. It can be hard to blow out the insides of the egg, like blowing up a really really tough balloon. If it's too hard, try covering the holes and shaking the egg again to break up the insides more, or you can make the bottom hole slightly larger.

Keep blowing until the egg shell is completely empty.

Step 4: Rinse the egg in warm soapy water, making sure to clean out the inside of the egg as well as the outside. You can run water from the faucet through the egg shell to help rinse out the insides.

Set the egg aside to dry, making sure the bottom/fatter side is pointing down so the water can drip out of the egg shell.

# How to make the EASIEST NO SEW SOCK BUNNY



## Instructions

**Step 1:** Take the sock and place it over a tall glass so its easier to pour the rice into. Pour the rice into the sock.

**Step 2:** Take the rubber band and tie the top close

**Step 3:** To make the head and body shape, take another rubber band and tie it between the head and the body.

**Step 4:** Use another rubber band and make the bunny tail.

**Step 5:** To make the ears, cut any excess sock so that there is a couple of inches for the ears. If you want floppy ears that flop down, then leave them a bit longer. Once the excess is gone, cut the top portion down the middle.

Using a marker, draw on a bunny ear shape. Take your scissors and cut along the marker line. Once done, your bunny ears should stand up straight (or flop down if you want floppy ears)

**Step 6:** Use the Sharpie to draw the bunny eyes and nose. To make the eyes, simply colour in two dots with the marker To make the nose, draw an "x" shape.

**Step 7:** This part is optional but it really adds a nice decorative touch to your bunny craft. Cut a long enough piece of ribbon and tie a bow around the bunnies neck. Use fabric or plastic ribbon.

## Some extra tips

To make smaller or bigger bunnies adjust the amount of rice used.

To make sock bunny's out of black socks, use a white fabric paint or Tipp-ex.

Make different types of bunnies. Some with floppy ears that don't stick up, some with shorter ears, some with longer ears that stick up.

Use different colour socks or even patterned socks.

Use kids or baby socks to make small bunnies.

Glue on googly eyes for the eyes and a small pom pom for nose, with pipe cleaner whiskers.


